HISTORY

Pastor Stephen and Kyla Martin dreamed of launching a church with one simple goal: connecting people to Jesus and the Local Church. This is the Biblical pattern we see: the Church is more than a place you go to, it's a spiritual family you belong to. Their vision was to build a church that was Biblically sound, spirit-filled, and that prioritized discipleship. A church that would embody Christ's command to go (Mark 16:15-16), make (Matthew 28:16-20), and empower disciples (Acts 1:8).

In the Fall of 2013, that vision became a reality when a committed group of local families gathered for launch team meetings in Harker Heights, Texas. As this initial group continued to grow, we formally launched Vintage Church at Cinemark Theaters on Sunday, January 19, 2014. Today, Vintage Church serves thousands of people in the Central Texas region. Our innovative approach to evangelism and discipleship serves as a model to churches around the world.

Our Name

In Genesis 22, the Bible tells us the story of God's promise to bless all the nations of the Earth through Abraham. We get a glimpse, thousands of years ago, of the promise that God made to save and redeem us through Jesus. Over 2,000 years later, His promise was fulfilled. Even though culture changes, one thing will always remain, God's Word.

This is where the name "Vintage Church" originates. The same Gospel promised to Abraham that came through Jesus Christ serves as the foundation of our lives. God's Word is vintage, just as good then as it is now.

THE CHURCH WE SEE

Prior to launching Vintage Church, Pastor Stephen and Kyla took time to write out a description of the church God had called them to build. Today, this document, called "The Church We See," serves as a guide for all we do as a church family.



The church we see is more than a place or a weekend activity. It's a spiritual family where Jesus is the center of our lives personally and our relationships collectively. The church we see is an unstoppable force for good that shines light into the darkest places of our world. 
The church we see is full of spiritual contributors. We joyfully give our time, talent, and resources to build up our spiritual family as we expand the kingdom of God on Earth.

BIBLICAL DISCIPLESHIP

Discipleship isn't a system, but it does have a pattern and framework. Jesus would regularly use parables or stories to help people understand the ways of God. Anytime you see repetition in the Bible, the intent is emphasis. The Parable of the Sower is repeated in every synoptic Gospel and gives us a framework for discipleship.

The Parable Of The Sower

Then Jesus said to them, "If you can't understand the meaning of this parable, how will you understand all the other parables? The farmer plants seed by taking God's word to others. The seed that fell on the footpath represents those who hear the message, only to have Satan come at once and take it away. The seed on the rocky soil represents those who hear the message and immediately receive it with joy. But since they don't have deep roots, they don't last long. They fall away as soon as they have problems or are persecuted for believing God's word. The seed that fell among the thorns represents others who hear God's word, but all too quickly the message is crowded out by the worries of this life, the lure of wealth, and the desire for other things, so no fruit is produced. And the seed that fell on good soil represents those who hear and accept God's word and produce a harvest of thirty, sixty, or even a hundred times as much as had been planted!"

Mark 4:13-20



FOUR ESSENTIALS OF DISCIPLESHIP

In the Parable of the Sower, we see the process of discipleship in the four conditions under which the seed met the soil. These are the four depths of discipleship: connection, service, growth, and leadership.

Connect

Grow

Leadership is a privilege, not a right, and we are called to use our influence to help and sacrifice for others. That is what leadership in God's family is all about. We empower others to lead through coaching, practical hands-on internships and residencies, as well as higher education for those called to full time ministry.

Servant Leadership Culture

By Jesus' definition of discipleship, leaders are those that serve. That means that every serve team member is a leader. You represent Jesus and our church to guests and members of our community. Leadership isn't about having the right answer every time or being perfect. But it is about having the right heart. We have defined in tangible and practical terms what that looks like at Vintage Church by defining our leadership values. Allow these values to become your values over time as you serve in our spiritual family.

A New Way To Lead

Jesus commanded his disciples to relate to one another in a way that was radically different from the world around them. In the family of God, the way to influence isn't through titles or positions but through service to one another. We must always seek to add value to others over ourselves.

But Jesus called them together and said, "You know that the rulers in this world lord it over their people, and officials flaunt their authority over those under them. But among you it will be different. Whoever wants to be a leader among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first among you must become your slave."

Matthew 20:25-27

By Jesus' definition of discipleship, leaders are those who serve. Leadership isn't about having the right answer every time or being perfect; it is about having the right heart. Allow this to be a guide as you serve in our spiritual family. All leadership is servant leadership. Leadership is a privilege, not a right. Leadership requires sacrifice.

Leadership Values What we value and how we say it.

Spiritual Family

The church is more than a place you go to, it's a spiritual family you belong to. This is how we say it: "Jesus is my King, and my church is my family", "You'll leave me before I'll leave you.", "I want more for you than from you."

Personal Discipleship

The strength of the church is best seen in our desire to follow Jesus and live our life his way. This is how we say it: "Who I'm becoming is more important than what I'm doing", "I will do the next right thing.", "I'm not where I want to be but I'm not where I used to be."

Servant Leadership

Leadership is about serving others and is a privilege not a burden. This is how we say it: "I am loyal and love others", "I serve enthusiastically." "I do what I say and graciously say what I mean."

Relational Unity

The effectiveness of the church is entirely dependent on our ability to remain unified. This is how we say it: *"I have a thick skin and a soft heart.", "I am kind, considerate and respectful to everyone.", "I guard my heart and refuse to be offended."*

Operational Excellence

What we do matters and has an eternal impact on the lives of those we serve. This is how we say it: "I care about my church more than Jeff Bezos cares about Amazon.", "I never ask permission to take responsibility.", "I will make it better."

Regional Leadership Structure

Jesus

Jesus is the Head of the Church and all authority delegated in the Church is delegated from Him. Leaders will be held accountable to the Great Shepherd.

Governing Elders

Our Governing Elder Team consists of local and external overseers who provide accountability for our Senior Pastor and Lead Pastors. They also provide accountability and oversight of finances and corporate compliance.

Regional Leadership Team

The Regional Leadership Team is comprised of our local Lead Pastors and the Regional Executive Pastor, who together are responsible for the day-to-day operations of our local churches and regional support staff. One of the local lead pastors also serves as the regional senior pastor who oversees this team.



34 ABOUT US

Essential beliefs make up our doctrine, and as Christians we must agree and be in unity concerning these beliefs.

The Bible

We believe the entire Bible is the inspired, infallible, authoritative Word of God and should be the supreme and final authority in our lives and faith. (2 Timothy 3:16-17; 2 Peter 1:20-21)

One God

We believe in one God who exists and reveals Himself in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit and is the creator of all things seen and unseen. (Genesis 1:1; Colossians 1:16; Deuteronomy 6:4; 2 Corinthians 13:14)

The following 3 hinge upon each other.

Jesus Christ

We believe Jesus Christ is God the son, the second person of the trinity. He was born of the Virgin Mary, lived a sinless life, performed many miracles and died on a cross for our sins. He was raised from the dead on the third day in accordance with scriptures, ascended to heaven where he is at the right hand of the Father, and will return again to establish his eternal rule as King over the new heavens and new earth. (John 1:1; 1 Timothy 3:16; John 3:1; Matthew1:18-25; Romans 9:5; Hebrews 12:2;Philippians 2:5-6; Revelation 1:7)

Humanity

We believe God created humanity, male and female, in the image and likeness of God. We believe life begins at conception and that our gender and sexuality are good gifts from God and likewise determined by God from conception. We believe every life is sacred because God is the originator of every life. We believe that sin separated man from God. Despite sin and separation, we believe all humans, male and female, from every tongue, tribe, and nation, are valuable to God, deserving of love and respect, and should be afforded the opportunity of the gospel of Jesus Christ. (Genesis 1:26-28; Genesis 2:7; Psalm 139:13-16; Matthew 19:4; Romans 5:12-21)

Salvation

We believe that salvation is offered by grace through faith in accordance with repentance and belief in the death, burial, resurrection, and reality of Jesus Christ. His shed blood for our sins and resurrection from the dead means that we can we be forgiven and restored into fellowship with God. (Genesis 1:27; Romans 3:23; 5:1; 6:23; Ephesians 1:7; Romans 10:9-10)

The Church

We believe that the Church is comprised of all those who acknowledge Jesus as Lord and Savior, and that scripture instructs believers to identify and regularly assemble with other believers to devote themselves to worship, prayer, teaching of the Bible, fellowship, and works of service. (Hebrews 10:24-25; Acts 2:42-47, 16:5)

The Holy Spirit

We believe the Holy Spirit is the third person of the god-head, and at the point of salvation the Holy Spirit fills each believer as a down payment of salvation to be a source of strength, assurance, and wisdom for daily life. (1 Corinthians 2:9- 14, 6:19-20; Matthew 3:11; Acts 2:4, 38, 39)

The Infilling of the Holy Spirit

We believe in a subsequent experience where the Holy Spirit fills a believer to overflowing and is empowered to preach the gospel with boldness and operate in spiritual gifts. (Joel 2:28-19; Matthew 3:11; Mark 16:17; Acts 1:5; 2:1-4, 17, 38-39, 10:38, 44-47)

The Gifts of the Holy Spirit

We believe the Holy Spirit has supernatural gifts to distribute to Christians for the instruction and empowering of every believer to demonstrate the power, reality and supremacy of God to the world. All believers are commanded to earnestly desire the gifts of the spirit. These gifts always operate in harmony with the Scriptures and when operated with balance and order, these gifts will bring glory to God and the light of truth to the lost. (1 Corinthians 12:1-31; 14:1-40; John 16:13-14; Hebrews 2:4; Ephesians 4:16; 1 Timothy 4:14; 2 Timothy 1:6-7)

Water Baptism

We believe all believers should obey Jesus in water baptism, by immersion, in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. We believe baptism is both a public profession of their faith in Christ as well as a spiritual sacrament where the old man is buried with Christ and a new man is raised to life. (Matthew 28:19; Acts 2:38, 8:36–38; Mark 16:16; Acts 8:12, 36-38, 10:47-48; Romans 6:3-7)

Eternity & Second Coming of Christ

We believe in the personal and imminent return of our Lord Jesus Christ and in the bodily resurrection of all people unto judgment. This judgment will bring everlasting life in the new earth for the saved and the punishment of hell and eternal separation from God for the lost. (Acts 1:11; 2 Peter 3:10-13; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-17; 2 Corinthians 5:10; Revelation 1:7, 20:4-6, 11-15, 21:1-5)

Communion

We believe that the holy ordinance of Communion should be received regularly by believers walking in fellowship with the Lord Jesus Christ as a remembrance and celebration of what the broken body and shed blood of Christ accomplished for them on the cross. (Luke 22:19-20; 1 Corinthians 11:23-29)

Biblical Marriage

We believe marriage is a covenant relationship between God, one man and one woman, for life for the purposes of mission, companionship, procreation demonstration of and Christ's relationship with the Church. The Bible limits the expression of human sexuality to a marital relationship between a man and a woman, which is the only legitimate and acceptable sexual relationship according to scripture. All sexual activity apart from this context should be abstained from. (Genesis 2:24; Leviticus 18:22; Matthew 19:4-6; 1 Thessalonians 4:3-5; Romans 1:26-27; 1 Corinthians 6:9, 7:2)

Tithing & Giving

We believe that Christians are called to be generous givers and to trust God with their finances. We believe the starting place for Christian giving is to return the first tenth of their income back to their local church as a way of honoring God and recognizing Him as first in their lives. Returning the tithe comes before the giving of other offerings and is the foundation of biblical stewardship. We believe all tithes and offerings should be given cheerfully, out of obedience and in response to God's word and God's goodness towards us. (Malachi 3:10; Proverbs 3:9-10; Leviticus 26:30; Matthew 23:23; 2 Corinthians 9:6-7)
