

Weekly Services

Our Family of Churches saw an average attendance growth of 32% from last year, with 1,684 people attending weekly services across Harker Heights, Belton, and Liberty Hill. Additionally, our church database shows 3,765 active adults and 5,643 active individuals, showing the church's reach and impact extends beyond just weekly services.

Easter weekend was incredible this year, with 3,819 people attending across all locations. This marked the highest-attended weekend in our church's history, with an increase of 31% from the previous year.

We are honored to be able to witness 1,630 individuals choose to start or restart their relationship with Jesus this year. At the same time, an additional 185 people declared their faith publicly through Water Baptism. We also received 918 Connection cards and 234 Start Here cards from individuals who took the next step of engaging in the church.

























Financial Update

Expenses

Local Ministry	23%	Includes expenses related to location-specific costs, including local ministry environments (weekly services, guest experience, Serve Teams, Vintage Students, Vintage Kids, Small Groups, leadership development, pastoral care), as well as local facility and maintenance costs, print needs, advertising, childcare, event catering, and related expenses.

Serve Teams

Currently, we have a dedicated and passionate

Serve Team of 705 active adult members. This
represents around 72% of our average weekly
adult attendance and 19% of our active adults
in the database.





We believe church membership is vital to your growth as a Christian and we make it simple and easy to understand. Membership University is an event designed to help you learn more about our history, shared purpose, values, and beliefs, as well as what it means to be a member of our church family by joining a serve team. This past year, we saw 438 people take that step and join a Serve Team.

opportunity for us to gather together and discuss how to apply the powerful messages shared each week. These groups align with our series and follow the curriculum crafted by our teaching team. We currently have 26 active Small Groups led by 42 leaders. These groups have attracted 287 active unique members, making up approximately 29.4% of our average weekly adult attendance.







Events

The Harker Heights and Belton Locations continued combined ONE Nights until January of 2023, when each location launched autonomous weekly Student Night services. Our Liberty Hill Location continued "After Parties" and grew to reach 30 students regularly on alternating Sunday Nights.



This Spring, each of our locations hosted in-person an 10-part student discipleship course designed to help students learn the objective truth of God's Word and give them practical next steps to apply those truths in their lives. Across all three locations, we saw over **50 students** complete 2:52 and grow deeper in their walk with Jesus.



Our 2023 Summer Camp was an incredible night. This year all content and service programming designed, planned, was entirely executed by Vintage Church staff, serve team members, and parents. We took **61 students** to Camp Buckner in Burnet, TX where they had an incredible time growing in their relationships with God through prayer, bible study, and worship. In 2024 we are aiming to bring over 200+ people for another amazing year at camp.





On Easter Weekend we were able to host our Annual Eggstravaganza outreach event at each of our locations. This year we had over 165,000 eggs for the egg hunts and over 190,000 pieces of candy donated by members of the church across all our locations serving thousands of families across the Central Texas area.



Crowned is a women's ministry designed to connect women and empower them to step into all that God has in store for them. Over the course of the year we had many Crowned events impacting over 694 women.



Forged is а men's ministry dedicated to help men walk alongside one another - engaging, equipping, and empowering them to discover the truth of their identity in Christ. These events occurred monthly, and impacted over 237 men.



Vintage Conference

In September, we held our first Annual Conference. 150 Vintage adults attended for 2 days of learning and connection at our Harker Heights location. Designed with our staff, pastors, elders, leaders, and members in mind, Vintage Conference provides an environment to engage with the best practices, philosophies, strategies of Vintage Church. This conference will occur every year and will grow to include guest speakers and more sessions.

One Child.

This fall, we partnered with One Child. One Child works with local churches all over the world to help equip children to meet their God-given potential by providing opportunities for transformational development. Our partnership is specifically in a small community in Honduras, where we will have the opportunity to take missions trips in the future. As a church, we sponsored 229 kids in this community.




In October, we took a different approach to leveraging Halloween for the Gospel. Rather than a typical Trunk Or Treat event, we created an outreach initiative called "Light the Night" where we selected homes in different neighborhoods throughout our region to host a "Light the Night" party in their front yard. These homes represented the church with flags, games, food, and connection for those coming through to trick-or-treat.

With 13 Light the Night homes and over 80 Serve Team members involved, we prepared and passed out over 5,274 gift bags to our families and neighbors across Central Texas.

At Belton, we are in the final stages of design and engineering and will be able to start bidding/contracting the project as early as the end of October. For Liberty Hill, we are finalizing the negotiations of a 12,000sqf new-build lease located and are estimated to be ready to move in between April and July 2024.

On August 23rd, we launched Vintage Christian Academy, a K-6 school, which provides families with an option for Christian education in our community. Currently we have 106 students enrolled and a team of 23 staff, aids, and full-time volunteers. To date, we fundraised a total of \$98,860 towards the startup costs of launching a school and scholarships.

Church Leadership College

This fall, we launched Church Leadership College in collaboration with Global University, with 20 students enrolled. Our institution offers an alternative to postmodern seminaries, focusing on God and the teachings of the Bible rather than secular ideologies. We strive to be an alternative to secular postmodern seminaries. With the average age of pastors in the US being 58.2 and with some denominations averaging in the late 60's, there's a dire need for younger, passionate leaders. Church Leadership College fills this gap by offering an affordable, biblically sound education.

Our program, built on the three pillars of Church Leadership, Christian Theology & Practical Ministry Training, prepares future pastors and church leaders for a lifetime of fruitful ministry. Regardless of their final career path, whether in ministry or the marketplace, the knowledge, and skills our students acquire will serve them throughout their lives. Our complete 3-year program is ideal for those called into full-time ministry, ensuring that upon completion, they will be prepared for a lifetime of effective Biblical ministry in the local church
